3. Radon

OAR 581-022-2223(5)(c) states that the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan must include a plan to test for elevated levels of radon as required under ORS 332.167.

4. Lead in Drinking Water

OAR 581-022-2223(5)(d) states that the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan must include a plan to test for and reduce exposure to lead in water used for drinking or food preparation.

The Redmond Proficiency Academy has developed a plan as follows for testing all buildings leased or owned by the school for lead in water. All fixtures used for drinking or food preparation will be tested by as required by OAR 581-022-2223(5)(d) and testing will be completed by April in the 2016-2017 school year. 5. Lead Paint

OAR 581-022-2223(5)(e) states that the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan must include a plan to reduce exposure to lead paint that includes the following compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule.

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, the charter school will only contract with certified lead based paint renovation contractors licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board.

6. Integrated Pest Management

OAR 581-022-2223(5)(f) states that the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan must include a plan to implement integrated pest management (IPM) practices as required under ORS 634.700 through 634.750.

7. Communication

OAR 581-022-2223(5)(g) states that the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan must include a plan to communicate results for all tests performed in accordance with the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan.

The Redmond Proficiency Academy will make all test results and detailed information explaining the test results available to the public within five business days of receiving the results. Results will be made available by posting the results on the charter school's website, sending notice of the results over the email system, and making the results available in hardcopy at the main administration office.
