APRIL 6TH-10TH: TEACHERS AWARD MID-SEMESTER PROGRESS GRADES

Teachers will determine a progress grade for student work that occurred between the start of the second semester and March 13th. This grade is placed into Alma by Monday, April 13th.



APRIL 6TH-10TH: TRANSITION PHASE FROM ONLINE LEARNING TO DISTANCE LEARNING FOR ALL

Teachers will continue to engage with students through multiple modalities (email, Zoom, i-Ready, Loom, etc.). Teachers will begin narrowing the focus of learning for each course a student is enrolled in and define how that will be measured using course rubrics.

APRIL 13TH: DISTANCE LEARNING FOR ALL BEGINS

Teachers will use Google Classroom (instead of Alma) to house assessments, assignments, and grades. Teachers will continue to engage students with enriching learning environments that are tied to essential learning goals or learning targets. Teachers will regularly track student engagement in their online learning environments, and design multiple pathways for students to demonstrate their proficiency.



END OF THE SEMESTER: AWARDING GRADES AND CREDITS

At the conclusion of this phase of RPA's "Distance Learning For All," teachers will award a final grade for the course based on the progress grade (beginning of semester two thru March 13th) and the second half of the semester (April 13th - end of year). Students will be able to earn the following grades that will be transcribed and used to award credit: A, B, C, or I.
